

CERTIFICATE OF CONSENT

IN THE MATTER OF, an application for Consent in respect of the:

Increase in area of Mount Horeb United Church Cemetery, consisting of one (1) addition: Land consisting of approximately 0.489 acres, bringing the total acreage within Mount Horeb United Church Cemetery to approximately 1.013 acres; physically located at 117 Hillhead Road, on lands described as Part East Half of Lot 2, Concession 7, being Parts 1 and 3, Plan 57R-5147, Geographic Township of Ops, City of Kawartha Lakes, Province of Ontario.
